Monuments and Plaques:

- a) All persons wanting to place monuments and plaques memorializing a burial within Stanton Cemetery are required to contact the Cemetery Sexton IN ADVANCE and obtain a Monument Permit issued by Stanton Cemetery Association by paying a fee of \$75.00 PRIOR to erecting or removal of ANY monument or plaque; ensuring a proper placement or removal of permanent memorials. Stanton Cemetery Association reserves the right to remove/order removal of/prevent placement of any monuments, plaques or any item being placed including but not limited to placement inside burial lot confines without obtaining required Monument Permit.
- b) Veteran's Plaques are required to be affixed to already existing monument or into a concrete base within the confines and designated space for monuments within a burial space, as determined by Cemetery Sexton for placement.

Non-Permanent Memorials, Flowers, etc... – are considered items not a part of a permanent grave stone or marker left at a grave these items are permitted directly after burial or observance of holidays (Memorial Day, Veterans Day and Labor Day) each year; 2 weeks after such observance all non-permanent memorials, flowers, etc... are subject for removal to allow for regular maintenance of the property. Any items left at a grave are considered abandoned and are required to be removed by cemetery personnel.
