

ORDINANCE 803

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF STANTON, NEBRASKA, TO ADOPT THE BUDGET STATEMENT TO BE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL; TO APPROPRIATE SUMS FOR NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES; TO PROVIDE WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STANTON, STANTON COUNTY, NEBRASKA;

SECTION 1. That after complying with all procedures required by law, the budget presented and set forth in the budget statement is hereby approved as the Annual Appropriation Bill for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011. All sums of money contained in the budget statement are hereby appropriated for the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Stanton. A copy of the budget document shall be forwarded as provided by law to the Auditor of Public Accounts, State Capitol, Lincoln, Nebraska, and to the County Clerk of Stanton County, Nebraska, for use by the levying authority.

SECTION 2. There are hereby appropriated the following sums of money deemed necessary to defray by means of taxation all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Stanton, Nebraska for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, not exceeding in the aggregate the amount of tax authorized to be levied. The objects or purposes for which such expenditures are to be made, the amount appropriated for each object or purpose based on the total tax value of \$45,071,632 returned for said fiscal year, including amounts due upon legal and valid outstanding bonds against said city and all special assessments and other taxes authorized by law, are specified as follows:

FUND - General All Purpose LEVY - .480000 AMOUNT - \$216,344.00

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
